If any VC do not return, VSA go to find them before the group move to the next activity. A bell is rung to signal the end of the activity and for the VC to return. Red tape will be used to cordon off locations on site that the other groups are using so that VC do not get mixed up in a different activity VC instructed to wear arm bands identifying them as a player in the game so that other FST and VSAs can help them find their way back to the correct activity.

Fatal injury from tripping, falling or bumping into a hazardous object	FST, VSA, VC	1	75	75	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As part of the rules of the game, VC are instructed to stay in pairs at all times, so one person can get help if the other has an accident. • FST points out certain hazards such as water, trees, roots, steps, fences. • VC shown map of site and areas where they are not permitted to go are pointed out. • VC only permitted to use the lawn by Honey Pot and Green Leaf, the main lawn, the Victorian garden, tennis court, orchard, Pavilion field and 7-acre field. • VC are told that the 10-acre field, trench, sheep field, mud run, lake, long house, round house, poly tunnel, low rope course and Hooke Court woods are out of bounds.
